Description

LOCAL AUTHORITIES, ENVIRONMENT AND YOU - GREENUP- 12/02/2024 – 15/02/2024			
Day 1. 12/02/2024			
Arrival of participants from each partner delegation and welcoming dinner, where the mayor of the town, José Luis Candela Galiano, welcomed them.			
Day 2. 13/02/2024			
The participants visited Ibi to inquire about various environmental issues.			
First, they went to the Biodiversity Museum (run by the University of Alicante and Ibi municipality) in order to learn about the mediterranean environment, its climate problems and the danger of illegal animal transport in Spain.			
Secondly, the participants came to AIJU Technological Institute. There, they were told about the development of new technologies and ecological raw materials to make toys, how they interest the youngsters and its decrease in environmental impact.			
Afterwards, the delegations returns to Tibi to learn about the town, its traditions and how contemporanean art wants to mix with nature in the presentation of Urban Routes and Art Trails (a project of La Mácula del Tiempo foundation, chaired by Eduardo Lastres).			
Finally, they could discover the historical relationship between water and Tibi, thanks to a guided tour to L'Ull de la Font, a natural mountain spring.			
Day 3. 14/02/2024			
The day began with a hiking route to Planises (Protected Landscape of the Sierra del Maigó), just to see the Mediterranean forest <i>in situ</i> , learn about its flora and fauna and why it should be protected.			
In the afternoon, the Silvotourism group invited the participants to discuss the concern for generating environmental awareness among citizens and active participation in society.			
Then, a conference was held about participation, transparency and good governance by María Victoria Javaloyes Ivorra (local development agent of Tibi Municipality). Three sustainable development goals were explained: promoting peaceful and inclusive societies for sustainable development, facilitating access to justice for all and building effective and accountable inclusive institutions at all levels. Also, she showed the participation and promotion of associations projects with the subsidies used.			
After that, María Magdalena Cardenal Carbonell, the social agent of Tibi Municipality presented the <i>Enrédade</i> programme: against unwanted loneliness. This programme was created by the coordination of the Red Cross and Tibi Municipality, like others as the <i>School Success Project</i> and <i>Grow up Project</i> . The main channel for action in these programs is volunteering. This was followed by a round table discussion and debate with the Red Cross volunteers and the elderly people they were accompanying. They shared their experiences and showed the importance of these projects in people's quality of life.			

At the end of the afternoon, a coordination talk about the last event was held by Andreu Garrido.

Finally, the farewell dinner was celebrated.
